

How to Play GoldBars

Basic Play:

- Dealer deals each player 5 cards.
- Each player has a table hand that can hold 5 cards.
- Players take turns playing one of their cards on any open table hand.
- Once a table hand has 5 cards, it is locked and players must play remaining cards on other table hands.
- After all the cards have been played, score each player's table hand.

Play by Play of a hand of GoldBars

4 players , first to 100 points wins.

Dealer deals 5 cards to each player and sets the rest of the deck aside for the next hand.

Player 1 - Dealt hand














Player 1 – Table hand



By looking at your hand you know you need a card with a 3. You plan to play your extra 2s on others hopping to get a 3 played into your table hand.

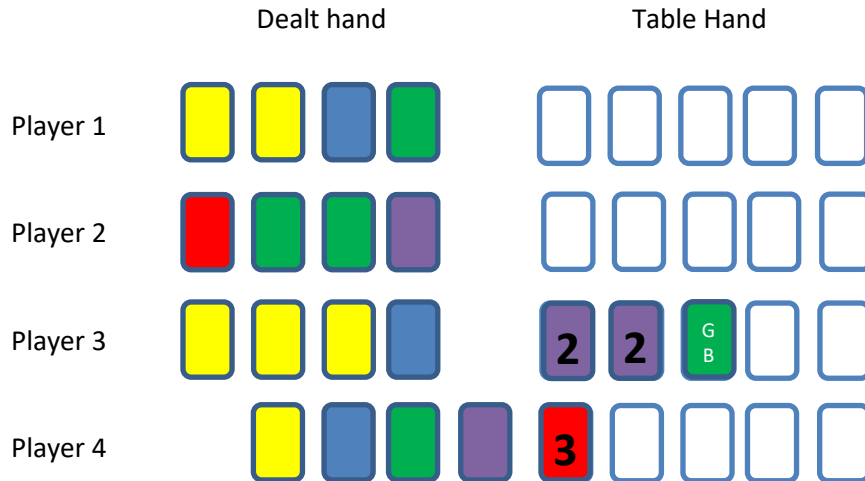
By looking at the color of the cards in play you also know:

Scoring with red is not possible. (You need 3 or more of the same color and there are only 2 red cards in play this hand.) and Yellow is the easiest color to collect. (6 of the 20 cards in play are yellow.) You decide to play your non-yellow cards in the hopes of getting more yellow cards into your table hand.

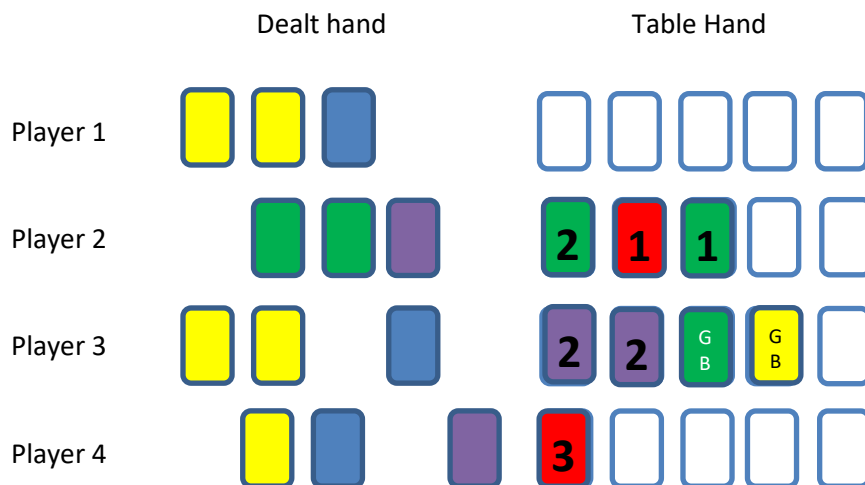
Playing card 1

Player 1 plays a purple 2 on player 3.
 Player 2 plays a purple 2 on player 3.
 Player 3 plays a green Goldbar on themselves.
 Player 4 plays a red 3 on themselves.



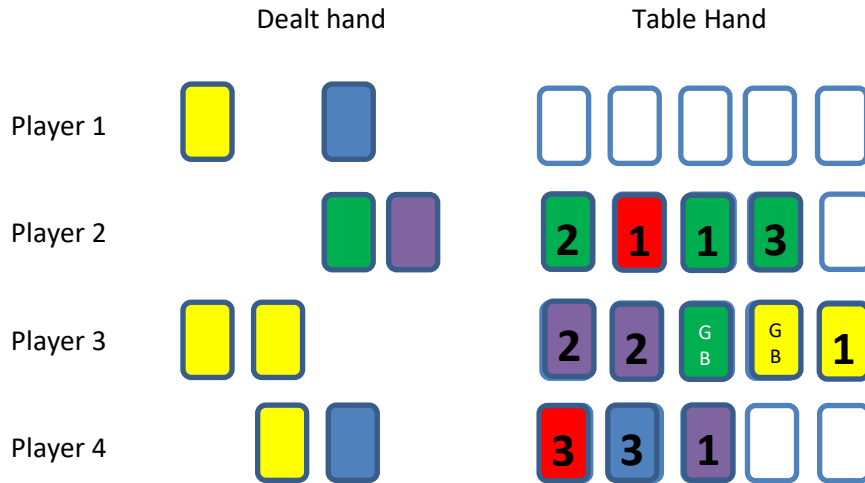
Playing card 2

Player 1 plays a green 2 on player 2.
 Player 2 plays a red 1 on themselves.
 Player 3 plays a yellow Goldbar on themselves.
 Player 4 plays a green 1 on player 2.



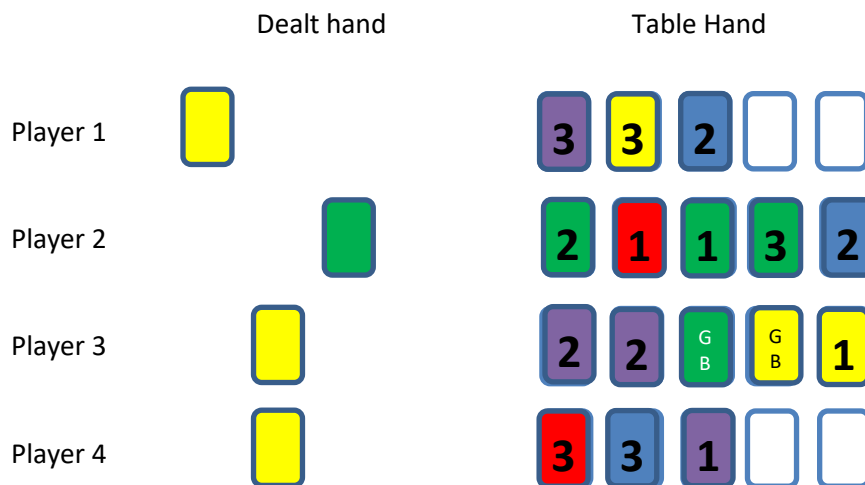
Playing card 3

Player 1 plays a yellow 1 on player 3. Closing that table hand.
 Player 2 plays a green 3 on themselves.
 Player 3 plays a blue 3 on player 4.
 Player 4 plays a purple 1 on themselves.



Playing card 4

Player 1 plays a blue 2 on player 2. Closing that table hand.
 Player 2 plays a purple 3 on player 1.
 Player 3 plays a yellow 3 on player 1.
 Player 4 plays a blue 2 on player 1.



Playing card 5

Player 1 plays a yellow 1 on themselves.

Player 2 plays a green 3 on player 4.

Player 3 plays a yellow 2 on player 4.

Player 4 plays a yellow 3 on player 1. Last card to be played.
